Any person present at a Council meeting may not orally report or comment about a Council meeting as it takes place but otherwise may; film photograph, or make an audio recording of a meeting; use any other means for enabling persons not present to see or hear proceedings at a meeting as it takes place or later; report or comment on the proceedings in writing during or after a meeting, or orally report or comment after the meeting. Anyone making a recording for non-domestic purposes is advised to seek advice on their obligations to ensure any processing of personal information complies with the Data Protection Act.

Anyone who objects to being filmed or recorded should notify the Clerk prior to the commencement of the meeting.

Coronavirus Regulations apply at this meeting. All those present must keep a distance of at least 1 meter apart. You are advised to wear a face covering. Members of the public must contact the Clerk if they wish to attend and will be admitted to the venue on a first come basis. Toilet facilities may not be available.
